An affordable Freiburg for all of us!

Over the past few months, on the doorsteps of Freiburg, my team and I have spoken to many people about their concerns. Based on these conversations, we have developed goals for our political work:

Lower rents. More to live on.

We finally need effective measures against this catastrophic housing market. I am committed to ensuring that housing is built by municipalities, rents are capped, and vacancies are eliminated. Every apartment must remain permanently affordable.

Strengthen care and daycare centers. Secure everyday life.

The state must invest in our social infrastructure and municipalities. Social institutions belong in public hands. I am fighting for good pay and more skilled staff in care, daycare centers, and clinics. For free childcare and education.

Reliable and free public transportation. Mobility for all.

We need a transport revolution. Local transport must serve the common good. That is why I am fighting for free buses and trains, frequent services, more staff, and investment in infrastructure.

I am committed to these issues – before and after the election.

That is why I am asking for your vote on **March 8, 2026.**

I don't want to become a professional politician. I want to make politics together with you and the people of Freiburg. I won't be able to achieve our goals on my own. We must apply pressure together. On the streets, in the workplace, and in parliament. There, I will always stand up for your concerns.

I will cap my salary on 2950 € and be available locally – at social consultation hours, neighborhood kitchens, and district meetings – because I want to fight for real change together with you. That's what I stand for. And that's what my party, Die Linke, stands for.
